I am Police Sergeant 2286 of the West Midlands Police, currently stationed at Steelhouse Lane Police Station.

At 0245 hours Sunday 16th November 1986, I was on duty together with other officers engaged on a uniform van patrol of the City Centre and surrounding area.

At this time we were instructed to attend a reported fight at the Sky Blue Indian Restaurant, Lozells Road, Lozells.

On arrival at the scene we were engaged in conducting an immediate search of the surrounding area in an effort to trace the alleged offenders whose description had previously been circulated.

At 0330 hours the same day the search having met with a negative result, I returned to the Sky Blue Restaurant. I entered the restaurant via the rear entrance, initially into the kitchen area, then I entered the main restaurant via an internal door into the ^{bar} where as a result of information I

received from witnesses still present, I took possession of three table knives, exhibit G-JN1, being a representative sample of the designs of cutlery in use at the restaurant at the time of the assault.

Later the same day I returned to Steelhouse Lane Police Station where having placed these three knives within a sealed plastic bag and completed an exhibit label I handed them both to Detective Constable MOORE, Exhibits Officer.
